The International Conference on Interactive Digital Storytelling (ICIDS) is the yearly meeting of researchers and practitioners in the field of interactive digital storytelling. Introduced in 2008 with a global scope, ICIDS supersedes two European conference series: the International Conference on Virtual Storytelling (ICVS), organised in France 2001-2007, and the Technologies for Interactive Digital Storytelling and Entertainment conference (TIDSE), hosted in Germany 2003-2006.

Since 2008, ICIDS has been organised in various locations, in Europe, Asia and North America.

The ICIDS Steering Committee invites peers with track record in the field to place bids to organise and host the next editions of ICIDS. Interested parties may submit an application form for evaluation (available at http://icids.org/). Contacting the ICIDS Steering Committee before submitting is encouraged (e-mail address below).

Selection criteria include: global and local ease of access to the venue; variation of location over recent editions of the conference, past involvement of the organisers in the ICIDS community; the mix of disciplines within the organising institution(s); the scientific standing of the organising institution(s), and more generally the scope and level of detail of information provided in the bid application form (budget, date, venue, committees, aim/theme, community building, etc.).
